Thank you for your request for information. Please find the response to your query below.

You requested to know:

I now require details of the dates when the over £500 data have been published for each month from July 2024 to March 2026, please also supply me with the files as csv or excel output - This data is now published on the council's website temporarily at <https://eastdevon.gov.uk/access-to-information/transparency-code/transparency-code-information/> As this information is already in the public domain it is exempt under Section 21 of the FOI Act 2000 - Information that is reasonably accessible to the applicant via other means.

It also appears from the screenprint evidence that I submitted on 7 July 2026 (copy attached) that at that time there was no published data for the current financial year April 2026 to June 2026 - The [Data.gov.uk](https://data.gov.uk) website have been having issues uploading the data we send them. This is the reason why data is not being uploaded until the council raises an issue. They have accepted that there is an issue with their systems. The council have been sending the data to [Data.gov.uk](https://data.gov.uk) on a regular basis. We are not responsible for issues with their systems.

This data for April 2026 seems to have been published AFTER my request - The [Data.gov.uk](https://data.gov.uk) website was checked following your enquiry and an issue raised with [Data.gov.uk](https://data.gov.uk) who rectified the problem and uploaded the data.

Please supply the date that this information was published - Information not held. This information is held by [Data.gov.uk](https://data.gov.uk). You will need to refer this part of your request to them.
